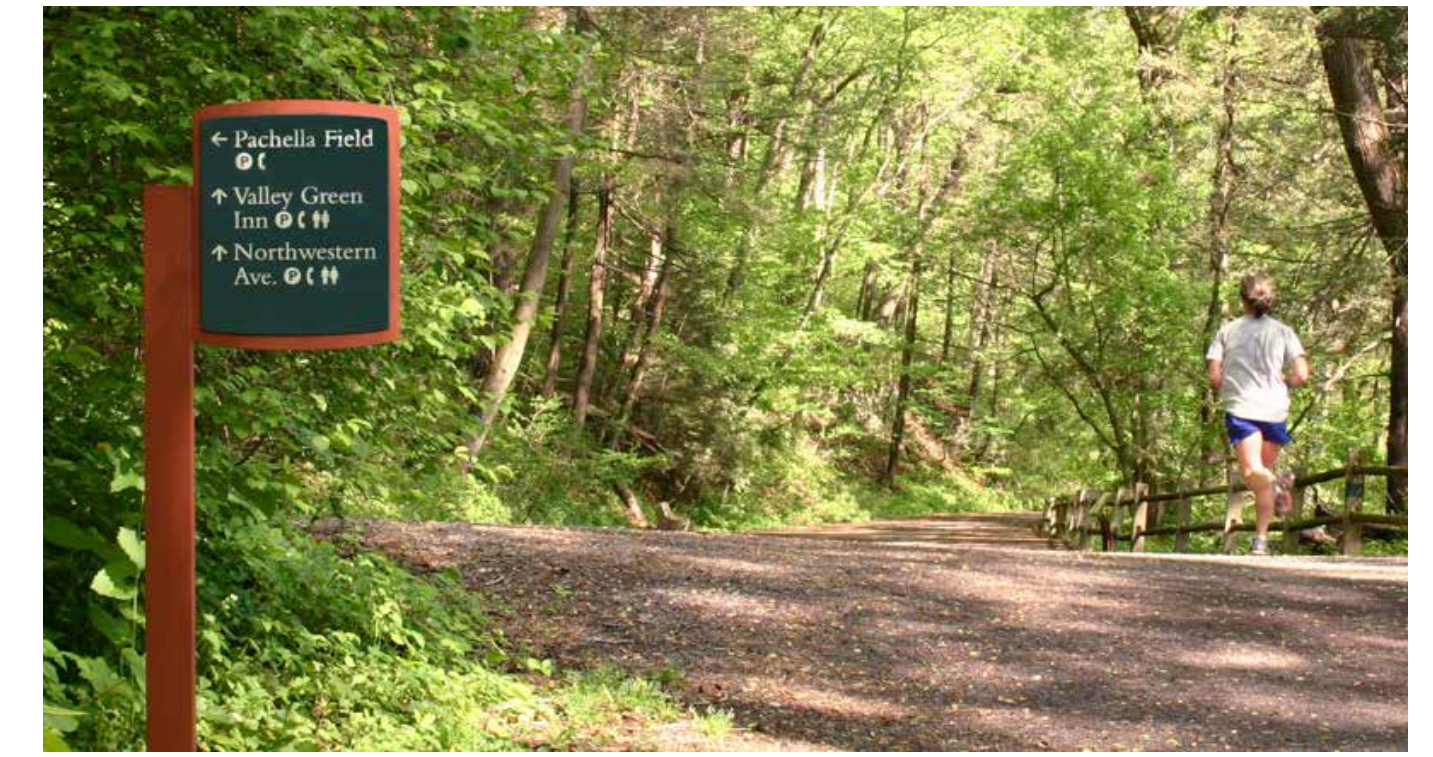
The Central Point Creekside (Boes) property is a recent addition to the city's network of public lands. The property is located on the northern edge of the city, along Bear Creek, a tributary of the Rogue River, and the Bear Creek Greenway, a 20-mile multi-use path.

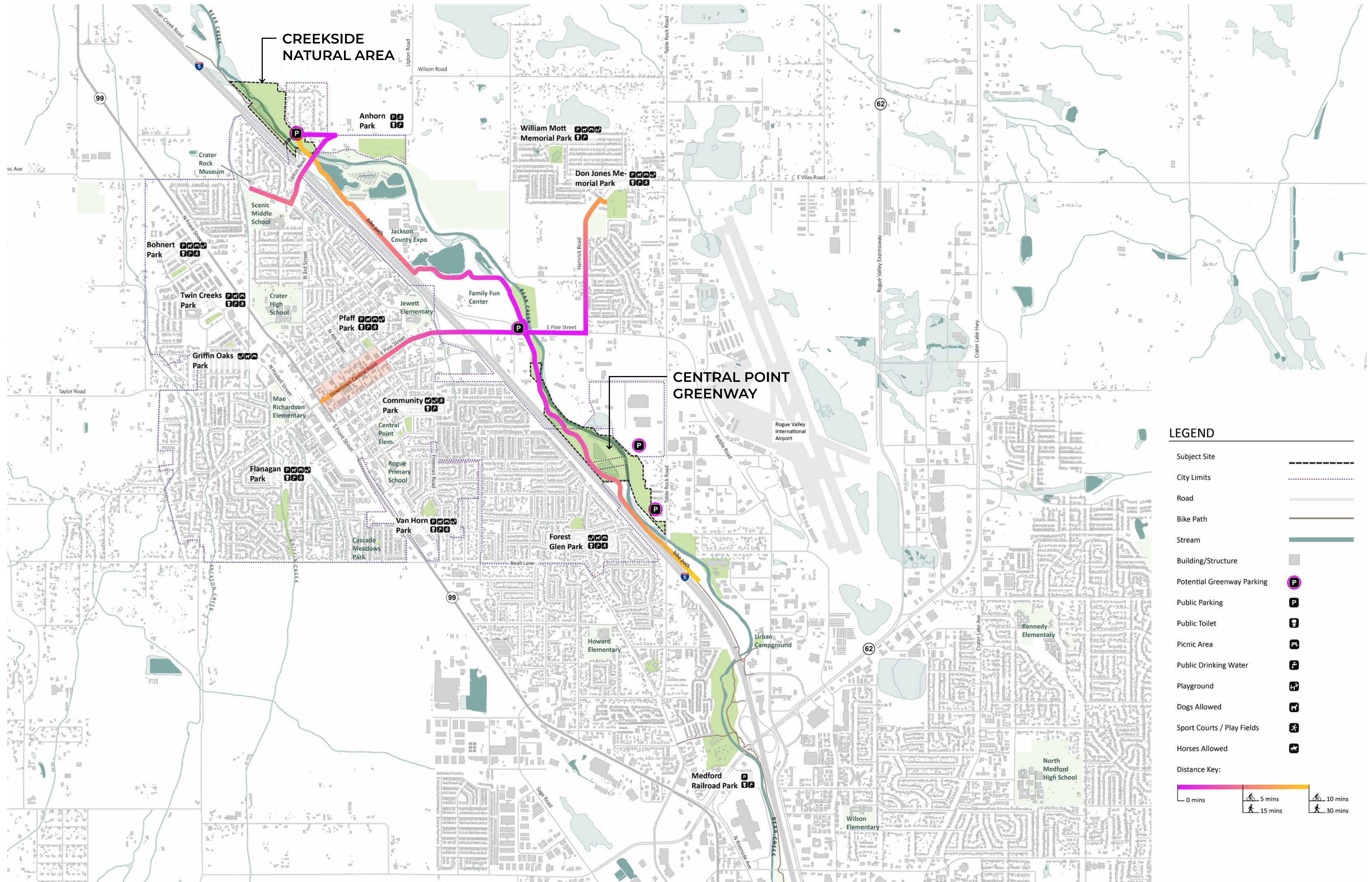
This project will create a conceptual site design plan for the 34-acre Creekside Property. The project site encompasses Bear Creek, riparian areas, stands of mature trees, two upland meadows, and diverse wildlife.

Preserving and restoring the natural spaces is a crucial objective of the park design. Simultaneously, the design aims to ensure public accessibility, allowing people to have direct and meaningful experiences with the natural environment, with outdoor education and wildfire resiliency being important elements of the design.

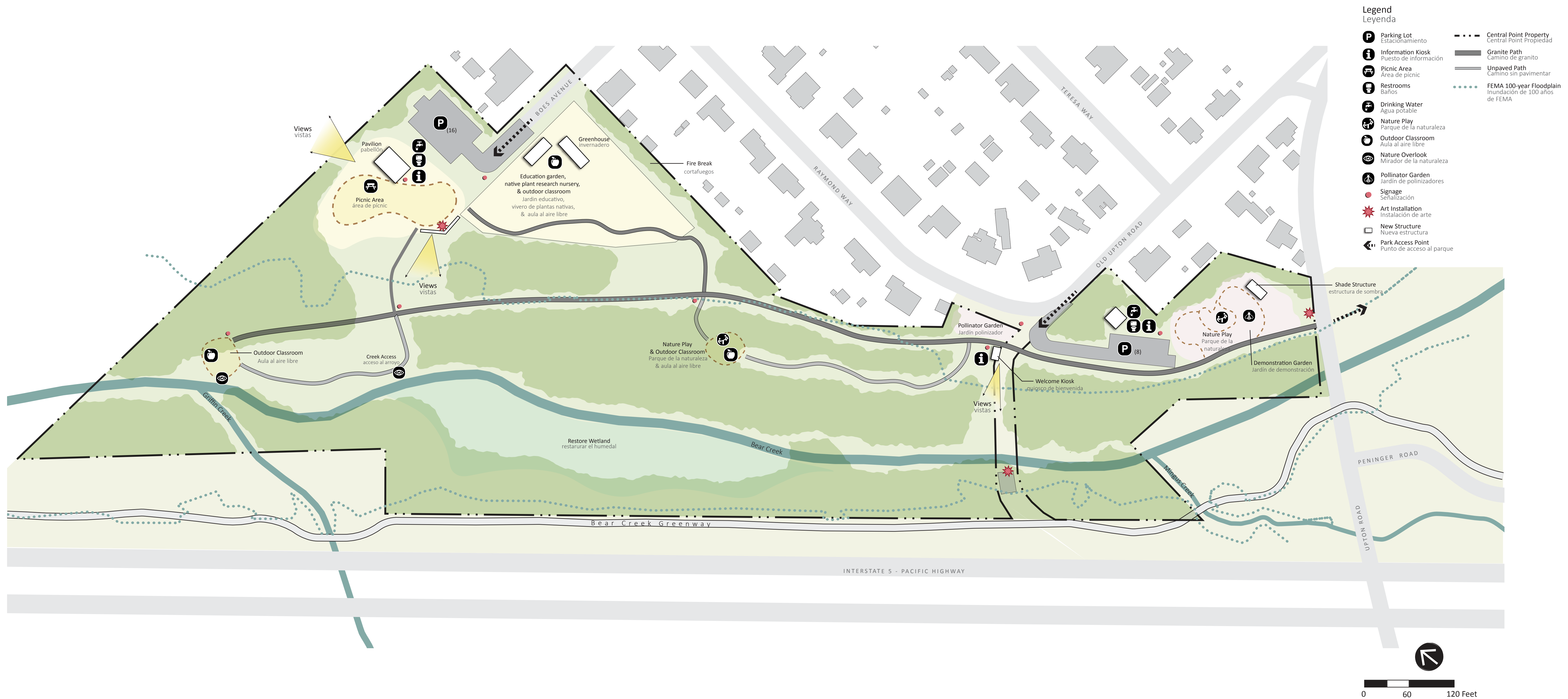

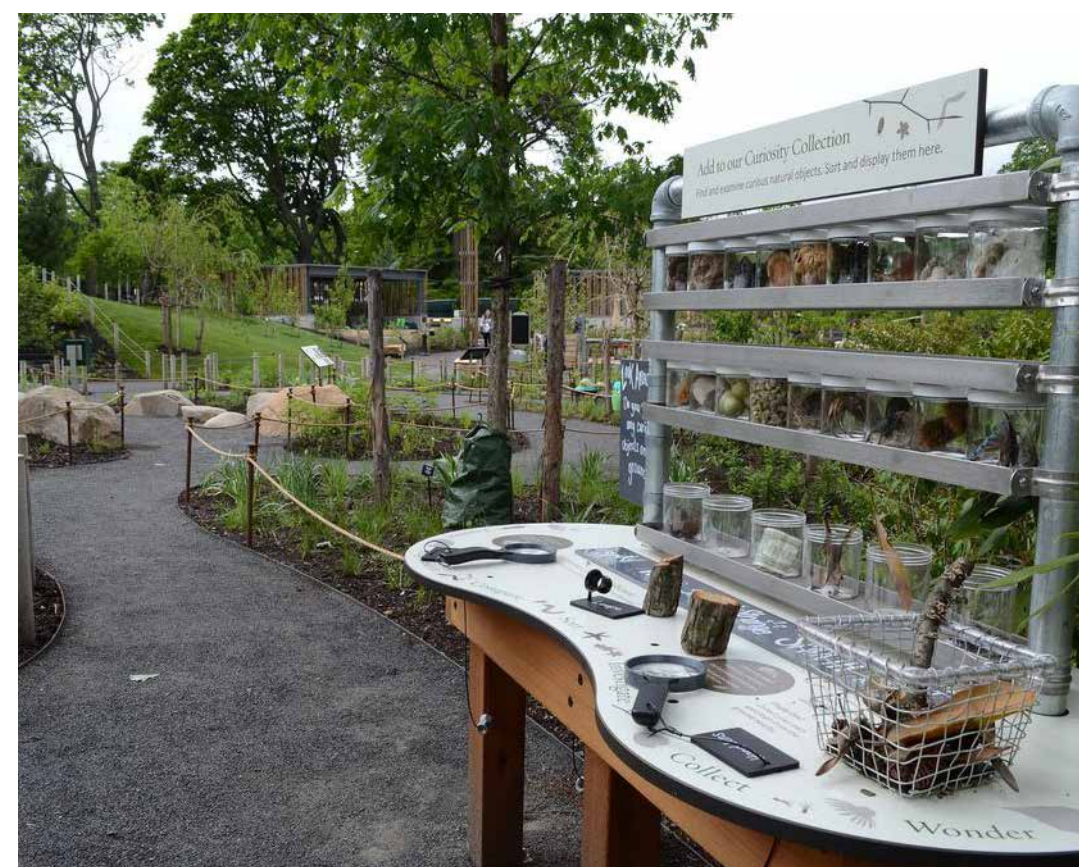




CONCEPT #1

This design concept focuses on providing outdoor recreation and education throughout the property. An outdoor classroom, greenhouse, and native plant research nursery would be located on the north end of the site. The southern end would have a demonstration garden and nature play area, accessed by a new parking lot. Access to the riparian area would be formalized with new walking paths and artwork would be incorporated into the existing road overpasses.

Este concepto de diseño se centra en proporcionar recreación al aire libre y educación en toda la propiedad. Un aula al aire libre, un invernadero y un vivero de investigación de plantas nativas se ubicarían en el extremo norte del sitio. El extremo sur tendría un jardín de demostración y un área de juegos naturales, a la que se accede por un nuevo estacionamiento. El acceso a la zona ribereña se formalizaría con un par de nuevos senderos para caminar.







CONCEPT #2

This design is anchored by a small Nature Center, which would include exhibit and meeting/ event space, education area, and be a jumping off point for tours of the natural area. This concept provides ample opportunity to access the riparian area and get close to the creek, including special areas for informal education and observation of the natural world. The southern end of the site would include a small pavilion and outdoor education area with native plant nursery.

Este diseño está anclado por un pequeño Centro de Naturaleza, que incluiría espacio para exhibiciones y reuniones / eventos, área de educación para D.I.R.T., y sería un punto de partida para recorridos por el área natural. Este concepto brinda una amplia oportunidad para acceder al área ribereña y acercarse al arroyo, incluidas las áreas especiales para la educación informal y la observación del mundo natural. El extremo sur del sitio incluiría un pequeño pabellón y un área de educación al aire libre con vivero de plantas nativas.
